The 2021 Learning A-Z UNICEF Kid Power Classroom Challenge Contest (the "Contest") is designed to empower eligible teachers and educators who are employed in a K-12 public or private school or school district, and who use eligible Learning A-Z online instructional resources ("Sponsor Product"), (collectively referred to in these rules as "Entrant," "Teacher," or "You") to encourage the students in Your Classroom, as defined within, to convert the most digital stars earned in the Sponsor Product into real world impact as donations to UNICEF Kid Power ("Donations"). The Entrant's Classroom with the most Donations will be the Winner, and the Prize will be awarded in accordance with these Official Rules (the "Official Rules").

By entering, You understand that You are agreeing to these Official Rules and providing Your information to Learning A-Z "Sponsor"). Any information You provide will be used in accordance with the Sponsor's privacy policy which may be viewed at: https://lazcommunity.force.com/knowledgebase/s/article/Privacy.

1. Eligibility. The Contest is not open to the general public and offered only to Teachers who are: (1) 21 years of age or older at time of start of the Contest Entry Period; and (2) currently full or part-time employees at a School or school district with a Classroom using, including trial and pilot users, an eligible Sponsor Product. A "School" is defined as a Kindergarten through 12th grade public or private school (1) located within the U.S. that is tax-exempt under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Service Tax Code or is registered as a public school with the National Center for Educational Statistics; or (2) located outside of the United States. A "Classroom" is defined as set of students with the same Teacher using a Sponsor Product. An eligible "Sponsor Product" is defined as any of the following Learning A-Z Products which offer star rewards: Raz-Plus, Raz-Plus ELL Edition, Raz-Plus Connected Classroom, Vocabulary A-Z, Writing A-Z, and Headsprout.

Contest is subject to all federal, state, and local laws and regulations. Void where prohibited by law. Sponsor's decisions are final and binding on all matters.

All prizes will be awarded to the winning Teacher's Classroom for the benefit of the Classroom and will NOT be awarded to the individual winning Teacher, nor the Teacher's School. Further, a Teacher may have several Classrooms, but the winning Teacher and Classroom will only be a single Classroom. Prior to entering, you must confirm whether Your School or district has any policies or restrictions concerning participation in contests. By entering into the Contest, You represent and warrant that Your School and district have consented to Your entry, including the School or Classroom's potential involvement in the Prize as described below, and that Your participation in the Contest does not violate any School or district policies with which You and the School are required to comply. The awarding of prizes is subject to any such policies. If, for any reason, any Teacher or their Classroom is unable to accept the Prize, including due to School or district policies, the Prize will be forfeited, and Sponsor will have no further obligation to such Teacher, Classroom, or School. Sponsor hereby disclaims any and all liability or responsibility for disputes arising between a Teacher, School, or district related to this Contest.

- 2. Entry Period. The Contest Begins at 12:00:00 AM Eastern Time ("ET") on March 5, 2021 and ends at the earlier of: (1) 11:59:00 PM ET on April 30, 2021; (2) or when 400,000 donations are reached globally (the "Contest Entry Period"). Sponsor's computer is the official time-keeping device for the Contest.
- 3. How to Enter. During the Contest Entry Period, any Teacher with a Classroom using and eligible Sponsor Product will be able to participate and will be entered into the Contest, unless the individual chooses not to participate either by: (1) selecting "turn off all incentives" within their Sponsor Product Teacher Dashboard ("Teacher Dashboard"), or (2) deselecting this specific incentive program within the Teacher Dashboard.

During the Contest Period, students in participating Classrooms will have the option of converting the stars earned as part of their usual progress, awarded to them by the teachers in accordance with the rules below, within the Sponsor Product(s) into donations ("Donations"). Classrooms located in the U.S. will have the option to donate stars which will donate meals to families in the U.S., and Classrooms located outside of the U.S. will have the option to donate stars which will donate water tablets to individuals across the globe. More information about donation equivalency and dollar value can be found in Schedule Abelow. All donations, in the Dollar Donation Equivalent amount, will be made by Sponsor to UNICEF Kid Power, who will make the donations in accordance with their policies and in their sole discretion, based on the communities of the most critical need. Teachers will be able to see the Total Donations made by their Classroom(s) via the Student Management Dashboard in the Sponsor Product throughout the Contest Entry Period.

<u>Awarding Stars.</u> Teachers may only award stars to students in the Classroom in accordance with the star system for all of the Sponsor Products, available at https://www.raz-plus.com/technology/student-incentive-awards/. If Sponsor determines, in its sole discretion, that a Teacher or anyone else has attempted to award additional stars to students for the purposes of this Contest, Sponsor reserves the option to remove the Teacher and Classroom from the Contest, and any future promotions, or take any other action it deems necessary.

TEACHERS LOCATED WITHIN THE UNITED STATES MAY RECEIVE SEPARATE COMMUNICATIONS FROM LEARNING A-Z ABOUT DOUBLING THEIR CLASSROOM'S IMPACT OF DONATING STARS VIA THE SPONSOR PRODUCT ("DOUBLE YOUR IMPACT"). TEACHER'S MAY CHOOSE TO SIGN UP FOR DOUBLE YOUR IMPACT WITH UNICEF BUT DOING SO WILL NOT IMPACT A CLASSROOMS TOTAL NUMBER OF DONATIONS MADE IN CONNECTION WITH THIS CONTEST. FOR CLARITY, THE DOUBLE YOUR IMPACT PROGRAM IS RUN ENTIRELY BY UNICEF AND HAS NO BEARING ON THIS CONTEST.

- **4. Determining the Winner.** After the conclusion of the Contest Entry Period, the Teacher's Classroom with the most Total Donations made will be the potential Winning Classroom of the Contest ("Winning Classroom"). In the event of a tie between two (2) or more Classrooms which have the same Total Donations made during the Contest Entry Period, the Winning Classrooms will jointly receive the Prize at the instruction of and as coordinated by Sponsor.
- 5. Notification of Winners. There will be one (1) Winning Classroom. The Teacher of the Winning Classroom will be notified via the email associated with the Sponsor Product account on or before May 7, 2021.
- 6. Prize. The Prize will be awarded to the winning Teacher's Classroom with the most Total Donations for the sole benefit of a single Classroom and will NOT be awarded to the individual Teacher nor to the Teacher's School. A Teacher may have several Classrooms, but there will only be a single Winning Classroom, except in the event of a Tie, in which case there will be more than one Winning Classroom.

The Prize will consist of the opportunity for the Winning Classroom, or Classrooms in the event of a tie, to collaborate with Sponsor on a student-driven book ("Student Book") to be published as a non-leveled PDF resource in RAZ-PLUS, as well as made available on www.learninga-z.com. The Student Book will be finalized and expected to be made available in the Fall of 2021, in accordance with the terms below.

The Winning Classroom will be working the Teacher, as guided by Sponsor, to develop the Student Book, on a topic to be chosen by Sponsor in its sole discretion. By accepting the Prize, the Teacher, on behalf of the Winning Classroom, agrees to follow the specifications, guidelines, and timeframes required by Sponsor in the publishing of Student Book, including but not limited: (i) adhering to content, language, and topic guidelines; (ii) working within any templates provided by Sponsor; (iii) participating in external and internal reviews of the Student Book; and (iv) submitting final drafts to Sponsor by applicable deadlines.

Learning A-Z shall exclusively own the Student Book (including, but not limited to any drafts, materials, documents, notes, methods, ideas, designs, concepts, techniques, models) created and developed pursuant to this Contest and the execution of the Prize. Immediately upon the creation of any portion of the Student Book, Company will own all copyrights in such the Student Book and have the right to use, authorize, or license third parties to use, the Student Book in any and all matter and media and in all channels of distribution (whether now known or hereafter devised) throughout the universe in perpetuity without any obligation to the Winning Classroom, Teacher, or School of any kind, including but not limited to any royalty payments or attribution.

To the extent that title to the Student Book (or any portion thereof) would, by operation of law, not vest in Sponsor, the Teacher on behalf of the Winning Classroom hereby agrees to irrevocably transfer, sell, grant, convey, assign, and relinquish exclusively to Sponsor all of its right, title, and interest in and to the Student Book, including all copyrights and equivalent rights, renewals, and extensions thereof, throughout the world. Further, to the maximum extent permitted by law, the Teacher on behalf of the Winning Classroom waives any and all moral rights which the Winning Classroom may have in any such Student Book (or any portion thereof).

Among other conditions detailed in these Official Rules, the granting of the Prize will be subject to all applicable laws, rules, regulations, and the approval of any applicable School and/or governmental agency, as well as the acceptance by such applicable School and/or governmental agency of Sponsor's requirements and conditions in connection with the award and execution of the Prize. If Sponsor believes that the potential award of the Prize (or any portion thereof) to a particular Classroom may violate any law, rule, or regulation, the Sponsor reserves the right in its sole discretion to award the prize to an alternate Classroom (the alternate being the Classroom with the next highest Total Donations), pending verification of eligibility.

No substitutions are permitted except Sponsor reserves the right to substitute or modify the Prize or portion of the prize with one of equal or substantially similar value in case of unavailability or other occurrence preventing the execution of the Prize. Sponsor reserves the right to cancel or modify the Contest if fraud, technical failures, human error, or any other factor impairs the integrity of the Contest as determined by Sponsor in its sole discretion. Sponsor reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to disqualify any Teacher/Classroom is finds to be tampering with the entry process or the operation of the Contest, or to be acting in violation of the Official Rules of this or any other promotion, or in an unsportsmanlike or disruptive manner. Any attempt by any person to deliberately damage any website or undermine the legitimate operation of the Contest is in violation of criminal and civil law, and, should such attempt be made, Sponsor reserves the right to seek

damages from any such person to the fullest extent permitted by law. Sponsor's failure to enforce any term of these Official Rules shall not constitute a waiver of that provision.

- 9. Release. Teacher, on behalf of themselves, the School, and the Classroom, agrees that: (i) any and all disputes, claims, and causes of action arising out of or connected with this the Contest or any prizes awarded shall be resolved individually, without resort to any form of class action, and exclusively by the appropriate state court located in New York; (ii) any and all claims, judgments, and awards shall be limited to actual out-of-pocket costs incurred, including costs associated with entering this the Contest but in no event attorneys' fees; and (iii) under no circumstances will Teacher be permitted to obtain awards for, and Teacher hereby waives all rights to claim, punitive, incidental, and consequential damages and any other damages, other than for actual out-of-pocket expenses, and any and all rights to have damages multiplied or otherwise increased.
